UPDATE AND SURVEY RESULTS FROM WICHITA COUNTY PATHWAYS

Thank you to community members for taking the community perception survey. Your invaluable feedback guided us throughout the years of the Pathways to a Healthy Kansas project. As we reflect on our work, we are especially proud of the following accomplishments:



We have worked closely with the City of Leoti and USD 467 to improve the safety of pedestrian traffic around our local schools by adopting a Master Bike and Pedestrian Plan, designating Safer Routes to School, and placing RADAR Speed signs at the edges of the School Zone.

In 2019, a new greenhouse was constructed on school property with a Pathways grant and an additional grant from ADM Grain. This greenhouse will allow students of all ages to grow plants and vegetables to observe, eat and sell.
